FALL TERM KEY DATES FOR ECONOMICS CONCENTRATORS

- Aug 30** **Advising Office Hours for the Fall begin.** [Walk-in advising](#) is available from 10am-4pm, Monday – Friday.
- Sept 4** **Ec 970 information meeting.** 2pm, Littauer Center 3rd Floor Lounge. This is required for all those taking Ec 970 this Fall. Information about selecting your Sophomore Tutorial section will be discussed. Check the [Ec 970 website](#) for descriptions and syllabi.
- Required meeting for thesis writers.** 4:30pm, Littauer Center 3rd Floor Lounge. Information about registering for an Ec 985 seminar will be discussed.
- Sept 5** **Ec 970 sectioning preferences due by 11:59pm.** You will be notified of your tutorial section by 5pm the following day.
- Sept 6** **Ec 985 lottery forms must be submitted by 12pm.** You will be notified of your seminar placement by 12pm the following day.
- Sept 10** **Ec 985 seminars begin.** You should attend your Ec 985 seminar even if you do not yet have a thesis advisor.
- Ec 970 tutorials begin.**
- Sept 12** **Last day to enroll in courses.** This is the last day to meet with a concentration advisor to discuss your courses and have your advisor hold lifted.
- Oct 9** **Last day to add/drop courses or change your grading option.** Thesis registration forms due by 5pm to Dani Doyle in Littauer 112. If you do not have a thesis advisor by this date, you must drop Ec 985.
- Oct 22** **Last date to withdraw from courses.** Last day for March degree candidates to file for a secondary field.
- Nov 8** **Economics Concentration Declarations Due.** To declare Ec, please fill out the declaration form and visit an advisor during [office hours](#) in the Littauer Advising Wing.
- Dec 5** **Last day of classes**
- Dec 11** **Ec 985 papers due to instructors.**
- Dec 10** **Last Day of Reading Period.** All Ec 990 theses are due to Dani Doyle in Littauer 112 by 5pm.
- Dec 20** **Last day of Exams.** Also, it is strongly encouraged for **Seniors to declared their track: Thesis, ACT, or Basic.** Declaring Thesis or ACT track officially registers you for the economics honors exam. **The honors exam will be from 3-6pm, April 10, 2019.**
