FALL TERM KEY DATES FOR ECONOMICS CONCENTRATORS

- Aug 29** **Advising Office Hours for the Fall begin.** [Walk-in advising](#) is available from 10am-4pm, Monday – Friday.
- Sept 3** **Ec 970 information meeting.** 2:30pm, Emerson Room 105. This is required for all those taking Ec 970 this Fall. Information about selecting your Sophomore Tutorial section will be discussed. Check the [Ec 970 website](#) for descriptions and syllabi.
- Sept 4** **Required meeting for thesis writers.** 4:30pm, Littauer Center 3rd Floor Lounge. Information about registering for an Ec 985 seminar will be discussed.
- Ec 970 sectioning preferences due by 11.59pm.** You will be notified of your tutorial section by 5pm the following day.
- Sept 5** **Ec 985 lottery forms due by 12pm.** You will be notified of your seminar placement by 5pm the following day.
- Sept 9** **Ec 970 tutorials begin.**
- Ec 985 seminars begin.** Attend your Ec 985 seminar even if you do not yet have a thesis advisor.
- Sept 9** **Course Registration deadline.** Last day to meet with an Ec Advisor to discuss your courses and have your advisor hold lifted (remember: office hours close at 4pm!).
- Oct 7** **Last day to add/drop courses or change your grading option (with a fee).** Thesis registration forms due by 4pm to Kate Baier in Littauer 112. If you do not have a thesis advisor by this date, you must drop Ec 985.
- Oct 21** **Last date to withdraw from courses.** Last day for March degree candidates to file for a secondary field.
- Nov 14** **Economics Concentration Declarations Due.** To declare Ec, please fill out the declaration form and visit an advisor during [office hours](#) in the Littauer Advising Wing.
- Dec 3** **Last day of classes**
- Dec 9** **Last Day of Reading Period.** All Ec 990 theses are due to Kate Baier in Littauer 112 by 4pm.
- Ec 985 papers due** to instructors.
- Dec 19** **Last day of Exams.** Also, it is strongly encouraged for **Seniors to tell their Ec Advisor their track choice: Thesis, ACT, or Basic.** Declaring Thesis or ACT track officially registers you for the economics honors exam. **The honors exam is 3-6pm, April 8, 2020.**
