## Lester Kissel Grants in Practical Ethics Summer 2019

Harvard College sophomores and juniors are eligible to apply for a Lester Kissel Grant in Practical Ethics to support research and writing that make contributions to the understanding of practical ethics. A number of grants will be awarded on a competitive basis for projects to be conducted during the summer of 2019. The projects may involve research for senior theses, case studies for use in courses, essays or articles for publication, or similar scholarly endeavors that explore issues in practical ethics.

The grant will provide the recipient with an award ranging from \$500 to \$3000, depending on the scope of the project and the estimated related expenses. Funds may be used to cover the project's expenses or, alternatively, as a stipend to enable recipients to pursue research in lieu of summer employment.

### How to Apply

- Outline of the Project
- Description of the work to be undertaken in its pursuit
- Short statement (1-2 pages) of the Project's potential value to the student and to the understanding of practical ethics
- Estimated budget identifying the expenses expected to be incurred
- Curriculum Vitae
- Unofficial transcript (fellowship recipients will be required to furnish official transcripts)

The **deadline for applications** is **Monday, April 15, 2019** and the names of the successful applicants will be announced by Wednesday, May 1, 2019. Grant recipients are expected to submit a short written report on their experience.
